

On April 26th the U.S. House of Representatives voted on adding the Denham Amendment to the 2018 FAA ReAuthorization Bill. Immediately following the vote, the ATA sent out a thank you press release to the House for including the Denham Amendment.

Truckers need to be aware of how their representatives are voting on the major issues which affect them. The Denham Amendment is one of the issues greatly affecting Truck Driver Wages.
